Suamico Summer Solstice Parade Rules & Regulations for Entry



1. You must be registered by June 17, 2009 to participate in the parade.
2. All parade entries must be family oriented.
3. All enclosed spaces must be well ventilated, especially where portable generators and automobile emissions are involved.
4. Entry participants riding bicycles, skateboards, inline skates, scooters, etc. are required to wear helmets.
5. All entrants must decorate their entry to match the theme of the parade.
6. Walkers accompanying floats must be kept to a minimum and dressed in themed attire or uniform.
7. Vehicles towing floats must be fully decorated (not obstructing driver's vision).
8. There must be one adult on floats where there are children under the age of 18.
9. All entries shall have two people (one on either side) to walk with the float, as a safety precaution for encroaching children.
10. Maximum length is equivalent to one semi tractor-trailer unit, maximum height is eleven feet, and width is eighteen feet.
11. All air blown inflatables must be able to deflate by the bridge on Riverside to continue to the end route.
12. All pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Pet owners are responsible for the safety and well-being of other parade entrants and the parade audience.
13. All entries must be in their assigned position by 9:30 am for roll call.
14. No one will get on or off a float once it has started down the parade route.
15. Any candy handouts are not to be thrown from the floats (hand-to-hand only).
16. No drinking of alcoholic beverages at any time before or during the parade.
17. Please leave your line-up area as well as parade route as clean as you found it (this includes the clean up of animals).
18. Well-trained horses may pull wagons and or floats. Please plan to have a clean-up crew with you on the route. You will be responsible for the safety and well being of other parade entrants and the parade audience.
19. The Parade Marshals may reject any entry that is declared not suitable for the parade.
20. Your packet with entry number, parade route, and pertinent information will be mailed/e-mailed to you after June 5.
